# Winston-Salem State University Board of Trustees Endowment Committee Chancellor's Conference Room, Thursday, March 16, 2017 Minutes

Committee Chairman Dr. William Harris called the Board of Trustees (BOT) Endowment Committee meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

### **Adoption of Agenda**

Mr. Benton moved and Mr. McIntyre seconded the motion to adopt the agenda. The motion passed.

### **UNC Management Company, Inc. Presentation (Endowment Fund Update)**

**Mr. Jonathan King** began his presentation by stating that the good news continues. When the markets are running, the key is to take advantage but also be aware that downside protection still matters. Our portfolio is always set up to make sure that we do have some downside protection built in.

- Page 4, Headlines
  - For the first half of FY 2017, UNCIF recorded a solid return of 5.8%
    - o UNCIF's 5.8% return for the six-month period beat:
    - o the 5.2% SIPP return (primary benchmark)
    - o the 4.8% median return in the BNY Mellon Endowment & Foundation universe (top quartile ranking)
  - the 3.8% return on the Global 70/30 Portfolio(1)
  - Through February, UNCIF's estimated FYTD return is > 8%
- Page 5, Return Summary
  - The Fund's 5.8% FYTD '17 return is strong on an absolute and relative basis ranking in the top quartile of the BNY Mellon Universe
- Page 6, Financial Market Overview
  - U.S. equity markets are at all-time highs - valuation levels are significantly above historical averages
  - Equity market volatility is near all-time lows
  - The post-election "risk on" market regime continues
  - The U.S. economic cycle is quite mature - almost 8 years since the last recession - but there are no signs that a recession is imminent
  - Inflation is rising and the Federal Reserve is expected to continue to raise rates in 2017
  - Equity markets seem to be ignoring the risk of "deglobalization" - trade barriers & growing populist / nationalist sentiment in the U.S. and Europe
- Page 7, UNCIF Positioning
  - UNCIF currently maintains a neutral to slightly defensive posture

- Most asset classes are close to their SIPP targets with the exception of Diversifying Strategies (5.0% under the SIPP target) and Cash (6.7% over the SIPP target)
- The 6.7% cash allocation gives us "dry powder" to take advantage of buying opportunities
- We believe that patience and discipline will ultimately be rewarded
- We continue to seek out "pockets of opportunity" - investments that are expected to generate 8% -10% + returns with modest downside risk (direct lending, niche real estate)
- Page 8, Asset Allocation Summary
  - Largest Over Weights at December 31, 2016:

Cash + 6.7% (zero target)

Private Equity + 1.1%

Largest Under Weights at December 31, 2016:

**Diversifying Strategies** - 5.0% - 1.2% Real Estate Energy & Natural Resources - 1.2%

- Long Biased Equity, Long / Short Equity and Fixed Income are within 1% of their SIPP targets
- Page 11, Economic Backdrop
  - Global economic growth is improving, spurred by fiscal stimulus as political leaders worldwide move away from austerity
  - Growth, however, remains significantly below the historical trend rate
  - Global monetary policy divergence:
    - o U.S. Federal Reserve raised interest rates at its December meeting with additional increases in 2017 expected
    - Monetary policy in the UK, Japan, Europe set to remain accommodative
  - Emerging markets are attractive from a valuation perspective but could suffer from a strengthening dollar, rising U.S. interest rates, and growing protectionism
  - Brexit, the election of Donald Trump, and key elections in Europe in 2017 add elements of uncertainty to the economic outlook
- Page 12, Financial Market Backdrop
  - We are currently operating in a low return environment
  - The low return environment is expected to persist going forward:
    - Historically low global interest rates
    - o Relatively high valuations on equities, particularly in the U.S.
    - Below trend global economic growth
    - Deflationary forces globally (globalization of labor, increased use of technology)
    - Reflationary forces are emerging in the U.S. - tightening labor market, loosening fiscal policy, tax reform, trade barriers
  - We continue to seek pockets of opportunities to generate attractive risk adjusted returns
- Page 13, Financial Market Backdrop
  - Equity markets have recently experienced record low levels of volatility
  - We do not expect the low volatility environment to persist going forward:
    - Uncertainty regarding the impact of the U.S. election
    - o Potential positives - tax reform, deregulation, fiscal spending programs
    - Potential negatives - protectionism /trade wars, strained relationships with allies (NATO) and adversaries (Iran, etc.)
    - Uncertainty regarding key European elections in 2017
    - o Growing geopolitical tensions - Middle East, North Korea, South China Sea, Russia, etc.
    - Divergent central bank policies and currency volatility
  - We believe that patience and discipline will ultimately be rewarded
- Page 15, Financial Markets: Public Markets Summary
  - Global equity markets, led by the U.S., have performed well in FYTD 2017; traditional bonds have been weak 2

- Page 16, Performance: Contributors and Detractors
  - Energy & Natural Resources bounced back strongly after being the weakest performer in FY 2016
  - UNCIF's hedge fund strategies (Long/Short Equity and Diversifying Strategies) lagged in a period of rising equity markets
- Page 17, Asset Class Returns
  - 4 of 7 asset classes beat their benchmark, 1 negative performer
  - Performance driven by strong equity markets (both private and public)
  - Diversifying Strategies continues to lag in strong equity market
- Page 18, Private Portfolio: Recap
  - UNCIF's Private Portfolio generated a combined 7.5% return in FYTD 2017, beating 6.0% return on the combined Private SIPP benchmarks
  - The Private Portfolio received \$183.2 million in distributions FYTD 2017
    - o Buyout: \$76.2 million
    - o Venture Capital: \$15.9 million
    - o Real Estate: \$54.9 million
    - o Energy & Natural Resources: \$36.1 million
  - The Private Portfolio was cash flow positive by \$26.8 million FYTD 2017
    - o Net cash flow from:
      - Buyout: +\$28.8 million
      - Venture Capital: +\$2.9 million
      - Real Estate: -\$5.1 million
      - Energy & Natural Resources: +\$0.3 million
  - Closed \$191.4 million of commitments during FYTD 2017
    - o Buyout: \$91.4 million committed (3 re-ups; 1 new; 1 co-investment)
    - Venture Capital: \$35.0 million (2 re-ups)
    - o Real Estate: \$65.0 million committed (2 re-ups)
    - o Energy & Natural Resources: No commitments
- Page 19, Private Portfolio: Annual Cash Flow
  - The Private Portfolio has been self-funding in recent years, driven by strong distributions from Buyout managers
- Page 20, Private Portfolio: Going Forward
  - Continued focus on enhancing UNCMC's reputation as a partner of choice
  - Continued concentration of commitments to fewer active core relationships
  - Manage commitment pace to avoid vintage year concentration
  - Continued focus on specialist managers across all portfolios
  - Remain focused on strong alignment and relationships with managers
- Page 22, Relative Return Summary 1-, 2-, 5-, and 10-Year Periods
  - The Fund outperforms SIPP & the Global 70/30 Portfolio and ranks in the top quartile of the BNY Mellon Universe for 3, 5, & 10 years
- Page 23, Asset Class Returns
  - All asset classes positive
  - 5 of 7 asset classes beat their benchmark over the period
- Page 24, UNCIF Performance Summary
  - The Fund's return ranks in the <u>top quartile</u> of the BNY Mellon Foundations & Endowments universe for <u>each</u> period
- Page 25, Long-Term Performance
  - The Fund has achieved its long-term objective across the 5, 15, & 20 year periods

- A traditional equity/bond portfolio has fallen short of this target over the long term
- Page 27, Our Fundamental Beliefs . . .
  - To best achieve the Fund's primary investment return objective:
    - o Maintain a long-term time horizon
    - o Portfolio diversification is a key component in managing risk
    - Focus assets with our highest conviction investment managers
    - o Alternative asset classes play a significant role
    - o Tactical portfolio shifts can be utilized selectively to capture shorter-term opportunities
    - o Downside protection matters
    - o The most important and difficult challenge is striking the proper portfolio balance between upside participation and downside protection
- Page 28, Wrap-Up
  - FY 2016 was a difficult year for endowment portfolios...
    - o For FY 2016 period, the UNC Investment Fund generated a -2.0% return
  - ...however, FY 2017 is off to a strong start with the Fund generating a 5.8% return for the first six months of the year (> 8% through February).
  - While "alternative" asset classes hurt performance in FY 2016, we continue to believe that a highly diversified portfolio with significant allocations to alternative assets provides the best return / risk profile moving forward
  - The Fund's 3, 5, and 10-year returns remain strong relative to benchmarks and peers (top quartile performance)
  - We expect the current market environment, marked by low bond yields and modest equity returns, to persist over the medium term, with a likely increase in equity market volatility in the coming months
  - We continue to seek opportunities to enhance the Fund's return potential while maintaining a disciplined approach toward portfolio risk






